TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Participants must have been born on or after 30 August 1979.
2. The nominated winemaker must be the winemaker principally responsible for the production of the wines they have submitted.
3. Participants must submit three (3) finished wines (in bottle, no tank samples). The combination of wines submitted can be either:
 - i) Two (2) red wines and one (1) white wine.
 - ii) Two (2) white wines and one (1) red wine.
 - iii) Three (3) white wines provided those wines are made from three (3) different principal grape varieties.
 - iv) Three (3) red wines provided those wines are made from three (3) different principal grape varieties.
4. Wines entered by participants must consist of either:
 - i) Three (3) wines deemed Australian by the Label Integrity Program (LIP).
 - ii) Three (3) wines deemed New Zealand by New Zealand Winegrowers.
 - iii) No nominations comprising of wines from both nations will be accepted.
5. Participants must submit four (4) bottles of each of these wines for the initial tasting.
6. Participants must be involved in both the production and making of each wine entered. As such, NV fortified and NV sparkling wines are not permitted for submission.
7. Between three (3) and ten (10) dozen of each of the winemakers two highest scoring wines must be made available for the running of the Award. The precise quantities will be decided by The Wine Society. The Wine Society will supply 50% of the wholesale value of the finalists wines that are to be allocated to the above mentioned events up to a value of \$80.00 per dozen.

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8. The Participant agrees should he/she be selected as a finalist, to attend a black-tie Gala Dinner in Sydney in November 2010.

9. Both the Winery and the Participant agree, should he/she be selected as a finalist, to comply with any reasonable request to assist in public relations activities associated with the staging of The Wine Society Young Winemaker of the Year Award 2010.

10. Both the Winery and Participant agree to refer to the Award as 'The Wine Society Young Winemaker of the Year' in all promotional activities.
