- Book a guided tour or create your own bespoke self-drive wine trail.
- Hire a bike to slow down and enjoy the beautiful scenery as you pedal between cellar doors.
- Pair your tastings with a delicious gourmet platter, vineyard lunch or dinner at an incredible restaurant.
- Many cellar doors have seasonal hours, so check their website before you go.
